

REVENUE SHARING

VDOT Revenue Sharing program provides opportunities for Wythe County to partner with VDOT to bring non-state maintained roads into the system. The county may apply or qualifying roads to be brought into the system with VDOT providing one-half of the construction funds. The other half of the construction is provided by Wythe County from the residents requesting the road to be brought into the system. In addition to the half of the construction costs, the residents are responsible for any utility relocation costs. Residents unable to present their share of the estimated costs upfront may petition the Board of Supervisors to establish a transportation service district to create a tax district to raise necessary funds for their share of the costs.

The following roads may be considered for Revenue Sharing:
